

CAMPER EXPECTATIONS

- You are expected to help build a caring, fun, and safe Christian atmosphere; BYC will only be as good as you make it.
- Camper participation in scheduled activities is important; Bible class and devotional attendance is required.
- You are expected to stay within designated camp areas as set by the director.
- You are expected to refrain from profanity, smoking, alcohol, and drugs.
- Do not bring any portable electronic devices such as cell phones, radios, CD players, iPods/MP3 players, TVs, or video games. Also, no knives, guns, or firearms will be permitted.
- You are expected to wear modest clothing. If you are asked to change, we ask that you respect the decision of the director. Shorts and skirts must come within 5 inches of the floor when kneeling.
- No muscle shirts, tank/tube/halter tops, or sleeveless shirts are permitted. Clothes should not be too tight (i.e. yoga-type pants, etc.) or low cut.
- Any camper who drives to camp must turn in his/her keys to the director at registration.
- Campers attending activities off campus must notify the director of their schedule in advance.

PRICE:

The cost for **Pee Wee Weekend** is **\$20** per camper and **\$20** per adult, snacks and crafts are included in this cost.

The cost for **Weeks 1-4** is **\$125** for pre-registered campers (if postmarked 2 weeks before the beginning of the session) and **\$145** for on-site registration. \$10 for Snacks and \$10 Crafts are included in the cost of camp. A \$20 deposit is required with your application for pre-registration with the remainder due at arrival. Campers within the same immediate family as well as campers attending multi-weeks will receive a \$5 discount (first week or camper will be full price). No refunds will be given.
